New Immunisation Schedule

- > Enhanced Influenza eligibility
 - All MAR from 6 mths to 64 years of age
 - All pregnant women
 - All Aboriginal people 15 years of age and over
- > Education and resources to accompany new schedule



Completion HPV Catch-up Program

- > Ends 31 Dec 2009
- > General Practice encouraged to place orders prior to Christmas closure
 - continue to administer HPV vaccine in fridges in 2010
- > As of 1 January 2010 – vaccines only distributed for Year 8 girls



SA School Based Immunisation Program

> Year 8

- HPV – 3 doses (girls only)
- HepB – 2 doses (all students)
- Varicella – 1 dose (all students)

> Year 9

- dTpa (Boostrix) – (all students)

> Local councils and community health

> Follow-up cards for all students not vaccinated at school

- Available from Immunisation Section



Vaccine Ordering

- > Audit currently in progress
 - Vaccine purpose built fridges
 - Provider numbers
- > Observe ordering – reduce risk wastage from cold chain
- > Christmas closure
 - No deliveries from 21 Dec until 4 Jan 2010
 - Orders will continue to be received at this time
