Aim of the course

This workshop aims to provide general practitioners with up-to-date information and hands on practice in a number of clinical procedures. Work stations will be taught in small groups and will each be 1.5 hours in duration. The workshop program will enable participants to provide supervised hands on experience through a series of skills stations.

Overview of content

Emergency orthopaedics/ plastering skill station.

Facilitator: Wakefield Orthopaedic Clinic

- fractures – clinical features, diagnosis, principles of treatment of limb fractures
- management of fractures of the face and skull, vertebrae/spinal column, clavicle/scapula/sternum, lower limbs/ankles/feet, upper limbs/hand/fingers
- dislocation of jaw, shoulder, elbow, fingers
- analgesia and relaxation
- plastering tips
- immobilisation equipment.

Suturing skill station.

Facilitator: Dr Peter Sylaidis

- suturing instruments, suture material, holding the needle, various suturing techniques, number of sutures, removal of sutures
- special suturing techniques for various wounds – principles of repair, flap wounds, repair of cut lip, lacerations around the eye, tongue wound, scalp, forehead, other facial lacerations, bite wounds
- excision and closure.

Basic life support skills station.

Facilitator: Dr Joy Treasure

- content – recognition of critically ill patient, airway management, resuscitation procedures
- skills – basic airway management, rescue breathing/ventilation, external chest compression, maintenance of CPR.
- fulfills basic CPR requirements

Eye emergencies skill station.

Facilitator: Dr Shane Durkin

- categories – acute red eye, sudden loss of vision in the non-inflamed eye, ocular trauma, examination of the eye, visual acuity, macroscopic examination, slit lamp examination, fluorescein examination
- ocular trauma – corneal foreign body or abrasion, flash burn, chemical burns, eyelid laceration or burn, blunt trauma, penetrating trauma.
